


Memory Registers View (key)

Callouts and their functions:

- Register Index: Points to the '#' column header.
- Register Stored Value: Points to the value in register 1.
- Selected Register: Points to register 4.
- Shift down register's values: Points to the 'Delete' button.
- Shift Up register's values: Points to the 'Insert' button.
- Copies register's values: Points to the 'Copy' button.
- Paste copied values: Points to the 'Paste' button.
- Clears the selected register: Points to the 'Clear' button.
- Gets back to the Calculator: Points to the 'Close' button.
- Saves all memory to iCloud: Points to the 'BackUp' button.
- Restores all memory from iCloud: Points to the 'Restore' button.
- Resets all the Calculator's memory: Points to the 'Reset All' button.
