General Overview

The RLM-12PX calculator application is an extensive set of tools and enhancements inspired in the real HP-12C Platinum calculator. It works in the same way, but expanded with 15 digits precision, 100 store registers, 1000 program steps and a complete set of menus to handle almost any financial and business problem (toggle tapping the [OPT] key). Also, the Display was expanded to show all the Stack registers and, in landscape orientation, the content of the financial registers, storage registers and program memory. The "HP-12C Platinum" calculator is an updated version of the famous "HP-12C" designed and introduced by Hewlett Packard in 1981. It is faster and include "RPN" and "ALG" logic.
